## **POLICY FOR USE OF PICNIC PAVILION**

Grace Lutheran Church, Belfast, Pa.

## Policy developed by Mutual Ministry Committee and Church Council; approved by Church Council June 6, 2002; revised September, 2007

- 1) The picnic pavilion and outside kitchen are available at no charge to any member of Grace Church for use for family functions.
- 2) No alcoholic beverages are allowed anywhere on the grounds of Grace Lutheran Church.
- 3) Smoking is not allowed within the pavilion or outbuilding.
- 4) The rental of a port-a-potty is requested. The church restrooms are available only if necessary.
- 5) The entire facility (pavilion, outbuilding, kitchen, picnic tables, grounds, and church building if used) must be cleaned and returned to the original condition they were found in.
- 6) All supplies, such as paper products and utensils, must be supplied by the user.

Church supplies may not be used.

- 7) The Church Council reserves the right to terminate at any time its granting of permission for pavilion and/or church building use for any reason such as the priority of a church function not previously scheduled, or abuse of this policy.
- 8) The user is responsible to provide compensation for any damages incurred.
